Addendum to the Interim Report – 8 March 2021

Further to my Interim Report dated 8 February 2021, I have engaged in discussions with Sport England, UK Sport, **sportscotland** and Scottish Gymnastics regarding the issue of jurisdiction covered in paragraphs 42 – 51 of my Interim Report. I now understand that the reasons for excluding Scotland from the scope of the Review initially were that safeguarding issues arising in Scotland fall within the jurisdiction of Scottish Gymnastics rather than British Gymnastics (even where individuals are also members of British Gymnastics) and that concerns had not been raised in relation to Scottish Gymnastics at the time when the Review was launched. I am grateful to the Commissioning Organisations, **sportscotland** and Scottish Gymnastics for this clarification and for considering the position on jurisdiction in response to my Interim Report.

The Commissioning Organisations have now confirmed that the submissions received in relation to Scotland are to be considered by my Review. This is to ensure that all individuals who have submitted relevant information from the Home Countries have opportunity to tell their story. I will consider these submissions carefully and seek further information in relation to them if I consider it necessary and proportionate.
